

UKS2 Learning for Life Curriculum Plan - Summer Term

Science

Light

This unit involves exploring how light travels, how we see things and considering how shadows are created.

Working scientifically

The children will take part in a range of investigations to explore the strand 'working scientifically'. They will think like scientists and will focus further on the recording side of investigations through the use of statistics.

English

Linked to the exciting topic of Ancient Greece, this unit studies the highly recommended novel 'Who Let the Gods Out?' written by Maz Evans.

Instruction and Journalistic Writing

The children will write their own set of humorous 'Sacred Rules' drawing from what they have independently read and a Press Release about an escaped prisoner.

Character and Setting Description

The children will use figurative language to write descriptions of various characters and settings from the novel.

Persuasive Writing

The children will write a holiday brochure persuading tourists to visit Ancient Greece. Daily spelling and grammar sessions will also be undertaken.
