

LKS2 Learning for Life Curriculum Tree (Cycle A) Summer 2024-25


Science

- **Animals including humans** – we'll be learning all about food chains, teeth and how to keep them healthy, and how the main organs of the digestive system work.
- **Our Local Environment** – following our visit to Bennerley Viaduct in June, we'll be learning about the habitats of some of our local wildlife. We will then use this learning to help encourage nature around our school.



English

- **'Tadeo Jones'** – this short, animated film relating to Ancient Egypt will act as inspiration for the children to create a letter describing their adventures!

Computing


- **Internet research** – recapping the SMART rules to safely use the internet to find out all about modern and Ancient Egypt.


